 - Think carefully before answering
- 2. Answer the questions asked during the assigned exam time.
- 3. Answer should be precise.
- 4. Plan the answer on a separate paper

Questions Example Design

1. Compositional: In this type of exam the questions usually starts with Enumerate,

Explain how, What are the reasons for ...? Why ...?

With their typical answers

Examples should be provided

- 1. what are the nursing management plans of schizophrenia
- 2. Define the following

Delusion, neologism, personality, hallucination

- 3. Enumerate causes of mood disorders
- 2. True or false type of exams:

In this type of exam a short sentence about a specific subject will be provided, and then students will comment on the trueness or falseness of this particular sentence. Examples should be provided

- 1. Autism is four times more common in girls than in boys.
- 2. Dysthymia refer to hypomania that shifts back and forth with mild depression for at least two years.
- 3. Sertraline is a tricyclic antidepressant.
- 3. Multiple choices:

In this type of exam there will be a number of phrases next or below a statement, students will match the correct phrase. Examples should be provided.

- 1. All of these are features of mania except
- a. Pressured speech.
- b. Flight of idea.
- c. Excessive spending.
- d. Low self-esteem.
- 2. All of these are deferential diagnosis of autism except
- a. Child schizophrenia.
- b. Hearing deficit.

- 3. Which of the following is the most common type of hallucination?
- a. Auditory
- b. Tactile
- c. Gustatory
- d. Olfactory
