



Relationship between Characteristics of the Wound and Healing Duration among Patients Treated during Home-Visits

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Abstract

Wound healing is a vital but complex process in humans, containing a multilayered process governed by chronological yet overlapping stages, which are composed of hemostasis/ inflammation part, proliferation stage, and remodeling phase. The wound healing complexity makes it susceptible to pause at several levels. Wound healing can potentially have influenced by Factors that affect cellular function and physiologic responses. This research aimed to investigate the wound healing duration and demographic properties and characteristics of the wound among patients treated during home-visits in Erbil City.
