ACI Certification Program Administrative Process Summary

ACI creates study materials, exams, forms, instructions and administrative policies needed to assess whether or not individuals have the knowledge and skills necessary to properly perform specific job responsibilities related to concrete construction.

In order to engage local industry stakeholders in the process, ACI does not directly administer its certification programs; ACI approves Sponsoring Groups (SG) to do so as agents of ACI. Sponsoring Groups must meet specific expertise and administrative criteria that is reflected in an application submitted by the potential SG to ACI for review.

Approval to conduct ACI certification programs allows the SG to order examination materials and services from ACI on a session-by-session basis, and member prices for related workbooks and study materials. ACI does not require SGs to offer educational programs to support the certification exams; SGs are free to assess the needs in their area and develop appropriate review/education/training programs. Also if approved, ACI will assign the SG to work within a specific geographical jurisdiction outside of which the SG may not conduct exam sessions without prior approval of ACI.

Approved SGs conduct sessions as follows:

- 1. Determine the appropriate Date, Location, and ACI-approved examiner for a testing session
- 2. SG advertises the session, receives registrations and registration fees
- 3. Order exams for that session directly from the ACI Certification Department by either Phone or Email
- 4. Order study materials (if needed) for that session from the ACI Member Services Department by either Phone or Email
- 5. ACI sends the study materials (if ordered) soon after the order is placed, and sends exam materials within two weeks of the exam session
- 6. The SG conducts the review/education/training program (if offered), and the examination session
- 7. The SG returns the used and unused exam materials to ACI for processing
- Individual exam results (and credentials if earned) are sent directly to the examinees unless requested by the SG to send as a package along with the SG session reports directly to the SG for in-country distribution
- 9. SG is invoiced for study materials (if purchased) and for exam materials used (SG is not billed for unused materials)
